

Railways to build 4,000-km DFC

THE RAILWAYS WILL build nearly 4,000 km dedicated freight corridor connecting industrial areas in the eastern and western parts of the country to southern India through major ports in Odisha and Andhra Pradesh, a document on the planned corridors says.

The proposed DFCS are part of the next big ticket infrastructure projects of the Railways. These DFCS are 1,115 km East Coast corridor from Kharagpur (West Bengal) to Vijayawada (Andhra Pradesh), the East-West corridor which comprises 1,673 km connecting Bhusaval Nagpur-Kharagpur-Dankuni (near Kolkata) route, and a 195-km Rajkot-Swan-Kalpakkam-Andal (West Bengal) route. The third is the 975-km North-South sub-corridor Vijayawada-Nagpur-Hatras (Madhya Pradesh) route.

Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India will soon begin the survey and will complete the exercise in a year.

These corridors will provide connectivity to Paradeep, Dhamra, Gopalpur Ports in Odisha and Vishakhapatnam, Ganavaram, Kakinada, Krishnapatnam and Machhalipatnam ports in Andhra Pradesh.

Pradesh, ensuring faster movement of goods and capacity enhancement in the over saturated sections of the railway network.

In a major boost to development of Odisha, the proposed Kharagpur-Vijayawada corridor will pass through the state's Kalinagar Industrial area, connecting it with southern India. The Kalinagar Industrial area will by then already be connected with the western part of the country via the Eastern DFC. The Kalinagar

Industrial area has ferrochrome and alloy industries, sponge iron plants, steel companies like Tata Steel, Neechal Ispat-Nigam, Mesco Ispat & Steel, Hindustan Stainless Steel, Yazdani Steel & Power, Maitan Ispat, among others.

Similarly, Odisha's Angul Industrial area, home to aluminium units, thermal power plants, heavy water plant, coal fields and iron and steel plants, will get an impetus with the new sub-corridor, connecting it to the Western part and the coalfields in the east.

DFCCIL is already building the first two freight corridors—Eastern Freight Corridor from Ludhiana to Dankuni (1,856 km) and Western Freight Corridor from Dadri to Jawaharlal Nehru Port (1,504 km)—at a total cost of ₹81,000 crore. These two are set to be completed by 2021. —PTI

2G scam: HC asks ED to reply to plea for release of attached properties

THE DELHI HIGH Court Monday sought response of the Enforcement Directorate (ED) on a plea by a firm, which was acquitted in the 2G scam related money laundering case along with former telecom minister A Raja and others, seeking to release its properties worth ₹22 crore attached by the agency.

Justice Brishesh Sethi, who was conducting hearing through video conferencing, issued notice to the ED on the application by Conwood Construction and Developers seeking to modify the high court's March 21, 2018 order by which status quo was directed to be maintained regarding release of the

SC rejects plea seeking JEE (Main), NEET-UG exams postponement

THE SUPREME COURT on Monday dismissed a plea seeking postponement of JEE (Main) April 2020 and NEET-UG examinations, which are scheduled to be conducted in September, amid spurt in number of Covid-19 cases, saying precious year of students "cannot be wasted" and life has to go on.

"Life has to go on. Life has to move ahead. Precious year of students cannot be wasted," the bench, also comprising Justices B R Gavai and Krishna Murari, said during the hearing conducted through video conferencing while paving the way for commencement of the exams as scheduled.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta told the apex court that due precautions and all safeguards would be taken while conducting these exams. —PTI

UP again posts highest vehicle sales; pips TN, Maharashtra

CBI books SEL Textiles, directors for bank fraud

THE CBI HAS booked Ludhiana-based SEL Textiles and its directors for allegedly cheating consortium of banks to the tune of ₹1,530 crore, officials said on Monday. The directors — Ram Sharann Saluja, Neera Saluja and Dhiraaj Saluja — have also been named as accused in the CBI FIR along with unidentified others.

CBI acted on a complaint from Central Bank of India, which alleged that the company and its directors defrauded the banks and diverted loans with an intention to misappropriate them between 2009-13, causing a loss of ₹1,530 crore to 10 PSBs of the consortium.
