

Conduct random RTPCR of 2% international passengers: Centre writes to states, UTs

THE UNION Health Secretary Rajesh Bhushan on Wednesday wrote to all states asking them to integrate Covid-19 surveillance into their routine surveillance activities and follow the revised guidelines for surveillance in three areas — incoming international travellers, sentinel sites such as hospital and laboratories, and within the community,

along with wastewater sample collection.

In a letter to all state principal and health secretaries, the states have been asked to screen 2% of the international passengers coming to India at random and send all positive samples for genome sequencing. The letter also asked states and UTs to monitor sentinel sites, including reporting of all influenza-like illnesses to the integrated disease surveillance teams, with the district surveillance officer testing 5% of these cases

through RT-PCR. All cases of severe acute respiratory illnesses have to be monitored at district level hospitals and select tertiary care hospitals. This data will be shared by the state Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme teams on a fortnightly basis, as per the letter. The laboratories have all been asked to upload their data to the ICMR portal to help in surveillance. The states have been asked to do community-based surveillance to identify large outbreaks, unusual clinical presenta-

tion or mortality through media scanning and indicator-based surveillance through the routine reporting channels, the letter said.

"In addition, revised surveillance guidelines also call for sewage/wastewater surveillance, which may provide early warnings on potential local surge of Covid-19," the letter read.

Three-pronged strategy will be adopted for genome sequencing, which is currently done by a network of over 50 labs across the country.

Karnataka: Sisters say stripped, assaulted for not repaying loan

TWO DAYS after two sisters were allegedly stripped and assaulted near their residence on the outskirts of Bengaluru, for not repaying a loan taken from an individual, police on Wednesday lodged an FIR after facing public outrage and arrested two of the accused men.

Police initially did not lodge a complaint after the victims approached them, it is learnt. Public pressure on the police came after a video of the assault emerged on social media.

Bengaluru (Rural) SP, K Vamsi Krishna, however denied allegations that police had refused to register an FIR and maintained that there was no police lapse.

According to the com-

plaints, the crime took place at a village in Anekal taluk, on Bengaluru's outskirts, on Monday. On Wednesday, police identified the arrested duo as Ramakrishna Reddy and Sunil Kumar — they have been held for allegedly assaulting the victims. Another accused, Indramma, is still absconding, according to police officers.

Police sources, quoting from the complaint, said one of the victims had taken a loan of Rs 1 lakh at an exorbitant interest of 30 per cent from Reddy. She was asked to repay the entire amount at once, which led to disagreements, sources said. SP Krishna, however, said the victims had taken a loan about Rs 1 crore from 11 people and had neither repaid the principal amount nor the interest.

Local residents, it is learnt, held a meeting to resolve the issue and the victim had agreed to repay the

whole loan. Despite the agreement, however, the accused barged into the victims' house on Monday and allegedly stripped and assaulted them. The victims, went to the local police station but the Inspector (name and station details withheld to protect victim identity) there allegedly refused to register the case.

The SP said that two months ago, locals held a meeting to resolve the issue. On Sunday, Reddy, Indramma and a few others went to the police station and gave in writing that they will resolve the issue and did not register any FIR, Krishna said. But on Tuesday, he said, the victims approached the police and filed a complaint. On the video, the SP said their primary probe shows the accused did not record the video.

Vice President polls to be held on Aug 6: EC

THE ELECTION Commission (EC) on Wednesday announced that election to the Office of the Vice President will be held on August 6 as the term of the office of Venkaiah Naidu ends on August 10.

As per Article 68 of the Constitution of India, an election to fill the vacancy of the outgoing Vice-President is required to be completed before the expiration of the term.

Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar held a meeting on Wednesday that was also attended by Election Commissioner Anup Chandra Pandey and finalised the schedule of the election.

"...Election Commission of India is privileged and honoured to announce today the schedule of election for the 16th Vice-Presidential Election," the Election Commission said in a statement.

The Election Commission had earlier this month also announced the date of the 16th Presidential Election.

As per the schedule, the last date of nomination for Presidential Election is June 29, polling on July 18 and counting of votes on July 21.

The tenure of President Ram Nath Kovind ends on July 24, 2022.

Can't recognise Lt Col Purohit due to lapse of time: Malegaon case witness

Mumbai: A witness in the 2008 Malegaon blast case took a court on Wednesday that he was unable to recognise accused Lieutenant Colonel Prasad Purohit due to the lapse of time. The Maharashtra Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS), which had initially investigated the blast before the case was transferred to the National Investigation Agency, had recorded the statement of the witness in 2008. The witness, who ran a business of arms, told the court that in 2006, he had sold ammunition to Purohit. The witness told the court on Wednesday that Purohit had arms licences as a military man and based on that, he had sold him ammunition once.

Tripura MLA booked for molestation at state Bhawan in Delhi

TRIPURA MLA and former Tribal Welfare Minister Mevar Kumar Jamatia has been accused of molesting a woman at Tripura Bhawan in New Delhi, police said Wednesday, adding that they have sent him a notice and booked him under sections of sexual harassment. The alleged incident took place on Tuesday and a call was made to the police at night.

Based on the complaint, the police detained Jamatia for questioning and later released him. Amrutha Guguloth, DCP (New Delhi), said, "The complaint is of molestation at Tripura Bhawan. A call was made around 2.35 am by the complainant. We served a notice under section 41A (appearance before police officer) CrPC to the accused."

An FIR has been registered under IPC sections 354 (assault on woman with intent to outrage her modesty) and 354 A (sexual harassment). Meanwhile, a senior officer from Tripura Bhawan wrote to the Government of Tripura about the incident, asking them to take "necessary action".

"It is to inform that a team of Delhi police had visited Tripura Bhawan twice yesterday night and met (complainant). They recorded her statement regarding her complaint against Shri Mebar Kr Jamatia, MLA. The police team visited again early morning and took both (the complainant) and Shri Mebar Kr Jamatia to the police station. This is for information and necessary action please," reads the letter sent by the Tripura Bhawan officer.

# RFID tags for pilgrims, UAVs to watch routes: Upgraded security as Amarnath Yatra begins

RFID (RADIO FREQUENCY IDENTIFICATION) tags for all pilgrims, UAVs (unmanned aerial vehicles) for surveillance of routes, deployment of over 80,000 security personnel – a multi-layer security cover is in place for the Amarnath Yatra this year.

The annual yatra, which was flagged off by Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha from the Bhagwati Nagar base camp in Jammu on Wednesday, is taking place after a gap of two years due to the pandemic – it is the first since the Centre revoked Jammu and Kashmir's special status on August 5, 2019.

The first batch of pilgrims will set off from the Pahalgam and Baltal base camps on Thursday. While 4,890 left the Bhagwati Nagar camp on Wednesday, the total will be much more since many reach Pahalgam and Baltal base camps on their own. The yatra will end on August 13.

"By far, this is the largest security arrangement we have made for the yatra this year. Besides increasing the number of personnel, technology is also being used. We have placed drones for aerial surveillance and

also tagged the pilgrims with RFID to keep track of them," said a senior paramilitary officer, adding that the heightened security apparatus has been necessitated by the higher threat perception this year.

Police sources said intelligence agencies have warned of a "high possibility" of a militant attack. "A multi-layer security system has been put in place. It is not easy for the militants to

break the security cordon but we can't take any chances," said a senior police officer.

Police sources said they are particularly worried about the use of magnetic bombs. "These are a real threat," said the police officer. "It is almost impossible to keep track of every vehicle, especially in congested areas like Srinagar city."

Besides the J&K Police, the Army, CRPF, ITBP, BSF and other

central paramilitary forces have also been deployed. A special team of police and paramilitary personnel will continuously monitor CCTV footage from security cameras along the route and at the base camps, said sources.

The Shri Amarnath Shrine Board has set up counters at various places, including airports, railway stations and bus stands for issuing RFID tags to pilgrims on arrival, on the basis of their ya-

tra registration slips and identity proof. No pilgrim will be allowed without this tag, said officials.

As the pilgrims will be trekking through high altitudes, the Shrine Board has decided to provide an insurance cover of Rs 5 lakh each. Sinha said the decision was taken on the recommendation of senior doctors of AIIMS in view of the effect of Covid on people's health.

Among other upgraded facilities, there will be battery cars to cover a distance of 2.3 kms between Baltal and Domel, and direct chopper service from Srinagar to Panjtami for pilgrims who want to complete the yatra in a day. Earlier, helicopter sorties were only available between Pahalgam-Panjtami and Baltal-Panjtami.

The accommodation facilities have also been upgraded. While 69,770 pilgrims could be accommodated during the last yatra in 2019, arrangements have been made for 1,26,570 yatris this time. The number of tents along the yatra routes have increased from 3,530 in 2019 to 8,480 this year.

The administration has made arrangements for 106 medical beds in the yatra area, and hospitals have been set up at Pahalgam and Baltal base camps. A total of 391 doctors and 940 paramedical staff members will be deployed round-the-clock, said Sinha.

# Amid sanctions, Russia becomes India's top DAP fertiliser supplier

INDIA HAS imported about 3.5 lakh tonnes (lt) of di-ammonium phosphate (DAP) fertiliser from Russia, which would be arriving during the April to July period. This comes amid Western sanctions against Russia in the wake of its invasion of Ukraine.

The imports have been contracted by Indian Potash Ltd, Rashtriya Chemicals & Fertilizers, Chambal Fertilisers and Krishak Bharati Cooperative at landed prices of \$920-925 per tonne, cost plus freight (CFR). This is below the rates paid by other countries for DAP, mainly from China, Saudi Arabia, Morocco and Jordan.

Bangladesh's Agriculture Ministry, earlier this month, awarded an annual tender for import of 8.12 lt at \$1,020-1,030 per tonne. Similarly, Indonesia and Thailand are reported to have paid \$992 and \$1,000 per tonne CFR respectively for 25,000-26,000 tonnes shipment each. Pakistan hasn't been able

to contract to late even at \$1,030 CFR, with the local currency's depreciation against the dollar adding to the uncertainty.

India contracting DAP from Russia's PhosAgro at \$920 per tonne CFR – which is also the price cap that the government has put on importers – is likely to put pressure on other suppliers, especially Morocco's OCP Group, China's YUC and Saudi Arabia's Ma'aden and SABIC. They may have to cut prices to retain market share.

"It is a smart strategy to diversify one's supply sources. We did in urea by importing a large quantity of 47,000 tonnes for the first time from the US. The same is being done by sourcing more DAP (the country's second-most-consumed fertiliser) from Russia at a discount to international prices," industry sources told The Indian Express.

Total DAP import arrivals for April-July are projected at 9.5-9.8 lt. Out of that, roughly 3.5 lt will be supplied by PhosAgro, with Ma'aden and SABIC's share at 2.8 lt, YUC's at 1.27 lt and OCP's at 1.03 lt.

India, in 2021-22 (April-March), imported 58.60 lt of DAP valued at \$4,007.50 million. The bulk of the 58.60 lt imported was accounted for by China (20.43 lt), Saudi Arabia (19.33 lt), Morocco (12.13 lt) and Jordan (2.46 lt).

Importing from Russia has presented problems from sanctions, forcing "innovative methods" of making payments. "The risk in this case has had to be borne by the seller (PhosAgro), since banks weren't willing to open letters of credit (to serve as a guarantee for payment) on the importers' behalf. Payments were then made by telegraphic transfer to the seller's account, upon the latter physically presenting the necessary documents (copy of invoice, certificate of origin, bill of lading, insurance policy, etc) 7-10 days after the cargo had set sail," the sources explained. The total voyage time from Russia's Baltic Sea ports is 25-30 days.

"The imports have come at the right time when sowings for the kharif season have just started and will peak in July," the sources added.

# 2 militants killed in Kulgam encounter

TWO MILITANTS belonging to Lashkar-e-Toiba (LeT) were on Wednesday killed in a gunfight with a joint team of J&K Police, Army and CRPF in south Kashmir's Kulgam.

IGP Kashmir Vijay Kumar congratulated the joint team, saying the gunfight site was close to the Srinagar-Jammu national highway – the route for the Amarnath Yatra.

On Wednesday afternoon, the joint team cordoned off Nowpora village, Mir Bazar, after specific inputs about the presence of militants. As the forces were zeroing in on the target, the militants opened fire. The forces returned the fire.

"In the ensuing encounter, two local categorised terrorists of proscribed terror outfit LeT were killed and their bodies were retrieved from the site of encounter," the police said in a statement. "They have been identified as Yasir Wani, resident of Wangund, Kulgam, and Raees Manzoor, resident of Chotipora, Shopian."

The two militants were "part of groups involved in several terror crime cases, including attacks on police/security forces and civilian atrocities", police said.

# Amarnath Yatra: NC, Cong, BJP leaders attend meet called by J&K L-G, Mehbooba skips it

LEADERS OF many mainstream political parties in Jammu and Kashmir on Wednesday attended a "high tea" meeting at Raj Bhawan on an invitation from Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha.

The meeting discussed the smooth conduct of Amarnath Yatra, which is being organised by the UT administration for the first time since the scrapping of J&K's special status in August 2019.

This was the first such initiative since the all-party meeting and the political leadership of J&K in June 2021. The meeting on Wednesday was attended by National Conference president Farooq Abdullah, BJP state unit chief Ravinder Raina, Pradesh Congress president Chulam Ahmad Mir, CPI(M) leader M Y Tarigami, J&K Apni Party president Altaf Bukhari, former J&K finance minister Muzaffar Beg among others.

People's Democratic Party (PDP) chief Mehbooba Mufti

and People's Conference chairman Sajad Lone, who is out of town, skipped the meeting.

The invites for the meeting, which were sent out Wednesday morning, did not specify any agenda. The PDP rejected the invitation, saying it was "futile to host agenda-less meetings" given the present scenario.

Congress's Mir told *The Indian Express* that the LG briefed the leaders about the arrangements for the Amarnath Yatra. "We are all on the same page that the yatra should be peaceful," he said.

# SP defends Akhilesh amid criticism for staying away from bypoll campaign

FOLLOWING criticism from within party and its allies for not campaigning for the bypolls to Rampur and Azamgarh Lok Sabha constituencies, which the Samajwadi Party lost, the party on Wednesday defended its president, Akhilesh Yadav, and said he has "proved to be the only obstruction for the BJP".

"Akhilesh Yadav is the target of conspirators... For 2024 Lok Sabha polls, not only will he hold public meetings in all zones and Vidhan Sabha constituencies, but

he will also visit districts of the state," said SP national spokesperson Rajendra Choudhary in a press statement.

Akhilesh has "reached new heights in politics due to his hard work and struggle, which is not possible while sitting in air-conditioned (AC) rooms", he claimed.

Among the principal reasons listed by local SP leaders as well as ally SBSP for the losses were Akhilesh's decision to stay away from the campaigning.

SBSP chief Om Prakash Rajbhar had said on Tuesday, "Akhilesh-ji is not coming out of

AC. He is not taking the lesson from the 2022 Assembly results. Just like he announced candidates in Assembly polls on the last date of nominations, he did the same in Rampur and Azamgarh. He was supposed to go out to hold public meetings, but he did not."

Local SP leadership in Azamgarh also expressed unhappiness at Akhilesh not campaigning for cousin Dharmendra Yadav. In Azamgarh, Dinesh Lal Yadav defeated Dharmendra Yadav by a margin of 8,679 votes. In Rampur, Azam's aide Asim Raja lost to BJP's Ghanshyam Lodhi by 42,192 votes.

# Consider using body cameras during arrests: Karnataka HC to police

THE KARNATAKA High Court has asked the state police to make efforts to provide body cameras to police personnel involved in carrying out arrests in order to maintain records for the arrest process.

The HC order comes in the context of a case where a petitioner, a law student, claimed Rs 25 lakh compensation from the state after police allegedly subjected him to humiliation by

handcuffing him during his transportation for production in court in a public bus after arrest.

The petitioner, Suprit Ishwar Divate, was arrested in a cheque bounce case filed in Belagavi region of Karnataka in 2019.

The HC rejected the state government's plea that Divate was handcuffed while being taken to court since there were not adequate police personnel on court duty at the Ankali police station, where he was detained. The court directed the state to "pay a sum of Rs 2 lakh as compensation..."

# Top Rampur cop says wants to jail parents with elopement complaints; apologises

THE RAMPUR Superintendent of Police (SP) landed in a controversy after a purported video of him saying that he wanted "to send to jail the parents who come with complaints that their daughters have eloped" surfaced on social media on Wednesday. In the video shot on Tuesday,

SP Ashok Kumar is heard saying from the stage, "A dramatic incident happened in Civil Lines recently. A Muslim girl was going with a Hindu boy, or a Hindu girl with a Muslim boy. So you should see in your family why this is happening. I would like to send those parents to jail who came with complaints that their daughter has eloped. You give birth to them and leave them (on their own)... One or two children are enough

who you can raise properly." The clip is from an event at Rampur Police Lines where people from different walks of life interacted with police.

After the video was shared widely on social media, the SP was quick to issue an apology.

Later, he wrote, "I would like to clarify that I do not endorse my own earlier statement. I don't have any such intention. I can't do so..."

# Anthrax alert in Kerala's Thrissur

*Thiruvananthapuram:* The Kerala government Wednesday sounded an alert in Thrissur district after Anthrax, an infectious disease which affects domestic as well as wild animals, was reported in wild boars.

The Thrissur administration said the presence of the bacteria was found in carcasses of wild boars in hilly regions of Athirappilly village.

Anthrax is caused by a spore-forming bacterium. It mainly affects animals. Humans can be infected through contact with an animal or by inhaling spores. Symptoms depend on the route of infection. They can range from a skin ulcer to difficulty breathing. Antibiotics cure most infections. Inhaled anthrax is harder to treat and can be fatal. ENS
