

Gurgaon couple arrested at IGI Airport with 45 handguns

NEW DELHI, JULY 13

THE CUSTOMS department at Indira Gandhi International Airport has arrested an Indian couple returning from Vietnam after they were found to be in possession of 45 handguns worth Rs 22.5 lakh. In a preliminary report, the National Security Guard, after examination, confirmed that the guns are fully functional and can be used with .22 calibre.

The accused, identified as Jagjeet Singh (41) and Jaswinder Kaur (31), are learnt to have admitted to previously smuggling 25 guns from Turkey worth Rs 12.5 lakhs, officials said. Officials

handed over their infant daughter, who was travelling with them, to her grandmother. Investigation revealed that they were procuring a handgun for Rs 5,000 to Rs 6,000 and selling it for Rs 40,000

to Rs 50,000, officials said.

"Ballistics report will confirm whether the guns are real. But in a preliminary report, the NSG has confirmed that the guns are functional," an official said.

Customs commissioner Zubair Kamili said the family arrived from Vietnam on July 11. He said Jagjeet was carrying two trolley bags which were allegedly handed to him by his elder brother, who had arrived from Paris around the same time that day and left the airport. Investigators believe the guns may have been brought from Paris.

Jaswinder allegedly helped Jagjeet remove the tags on the bags, which contained the firearms. The customs officers

intercepted the couple while they were moving to the exit gate, and found the guns.

Kamili said: "The accused were arrested under section 104 of the Customs Act (power to arrest), and the trolleys along with firearms were seized under section 110 of the Act (seizure of goods.) Further investigation is in progress."

"The couple are in the exports and construction business. They have been staying in Gurgaon for the past five years. They went to Vietnam six days ago," the officials said.

During questioning, the couple claimed they were told by one of their friends that it is legal to procure handguns from abroad and sell them in India.

DTC staffer murder: Two more held

New Delhi: Two men were arrested from Delhi's Southeast district and Gujarat, days after the murder of DTC employee Sanjeev Kumar. The accused were identified as 42-year-old Iqbal Ansari, who is a cousin of Kumar's wife Najma, and 34-year-old Manish Mishra, the shooter. Earlier, Najma (28), Kumar's former wife Geeta (44) and daughter Komal (21) were arrested for their involvement in the case. Ansari had allegedly helped arrange for Mishra to kill Kumar.

Delhi Metro reaches 76% of pre-Covid figures

New Delhi: Metro has recovered around 76 per cent of pre-Covid ridership and hopes to achieve 100 per cent in the coming months, Delhi Metro Rail Corporation MD Vikas Kumar said, adding that conditions have improved since last week after schools and colleges reopened. "It is not only Delhi Metro. Covid has impacted Metro services globally and almost all networks across the world still have a 20 per cent gap in bringing back ridership," Kumar said.

Two arrested for attacking car with rods

Noida: Two men have been arrested for allegedly damaging a Thar vehicle with iron rods in Dabri, Wednesday. The accused have been identified as Aniket and Harish and are residents of Noida, police said. The incident took place near Nagar Palika cut at GT Road, Dabri. "The occupants of the vehicle escaped unhurt. The car is owned by Adnan Qureshi who runs a scrap business. We found that Aniket had threatened Qureshi, demanding half of his scrap business," police said. ENS

DTC to stop buses for schools in city

New Delhi: The Delhi Transport Corporation has stopped providing buses to schools in the city from the new academic session in view of growing demand of its fleet for public transport here, officials said on Wednesday. The decision was taken by senior officials of the transport department and Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC) considering the need for more buses for commuters, a senior transport department officer said, adding that the schools were informed in advance. 14 Chinese nationals overstaying in country detained from Noida

Noida: A group of 14 Chinese citizens residing in India on expired business visas were detained by Noida Police based on informa-

tion provided by the Local Intelligence Unit (LIU), Noida, Wednesday. The group has been sent to a detention centre in Delhi.

They had been living in Noida for the past one year and were working in a mobile company in Phase 2, police said.

"Out of the 14 people, some had flown into India in 2019 and others in January 2020," said DCP (Noida) Rajesh S. ENS
